



Intrastate Regulation Issues

In an initial decision filed by Administrative Law Judge, Michael Chappell, the Kentucky Household Goods Carriers Association has been charged with violation of the FTC Act by engaging in horizontal price-fixing. They have been ordered to take actions to withdraw or cancel existing tariffs and cease from developing tariffs that contain collective rates for the intrastate transportation of property and related services, goods or equipment.

This means Kentucky must change the way they oversee the rate-setting process in compliance with the FTC Act or deregulate household goods transportation in Kentucky. We will keep you posted as information becomes available.
